This Pendle Ski Club staying Covid-19 secure in 2020 policy statement provides the framework for the Club to achieve good practice and compliance with legislative requirements and approved codes of practice.

The Pendle Ski Club Committee have implemented this policy statement and all required processes, procedures and records.

Pendle Ski Club confirms that we have complied with the government's "guidance for people who work in grassroots sport and gym/leisure facilities"

- **We have carried out a Covid-19 risk assessment**
- **We have kept our members and facility users informed**
- **We have considered who should volunteer and how shift patterns should be organised**
- **We have taken all reasonable steps to maintain a 2m distance on site**
- **We have cleaning, hand washing and hygiene procedures in place**
- **Where people cannot be 2m apart, we have done everything we can to manage transmission risk**

All volunteers, club members and members of the public are asked to report any issues or concerns to the duty officer or a committee member.

This policy has been communicated to all volunteers and members, is available to other interested parties and is reviewed on a regular basis or when there are changes in government policy, containment or transmission risk. In addition, all volunteers and committee members have been made aware of their roles and responsibilities to ensure that all Club activity is conducted with the highest level of care and attention to health and safety requirements.


